Selecting a Topic

[*The Encyclopedia of Conflicts Since World War II*](#) lists different conflicts since World War II.

You may look through the print volumes for ideas on which Rebellion or Conflict to explore. The articles are short 2-4 pages, and provide excellent descriptions, sub-sections, and a map of the location. Photocopy off anything you need. If you use the book cite in this way (just fill in the title, volume number and range of page numbers).
